Cabins at Island Lodge

Your accommodations at Island Lodge will consist of a comfortable log cabin with lake views. Each carpeted cabin has its own bathroom with shower, an oil or wood stove for heat, and twin or queen beds with down quilts.

Also available is a wood-heated recreational cabin with full sized pool table, dartboard and poker table; as well as a wood-heated lakeside sauna.

Our main lodge building provides a large family-style dining area, and a comfortable sitting area with the best view on the lake; as well as room for games, movies, reading or review of your daily photos.

Getting there:

Because of its remoteness, Lake Clark is accessible by airplane only. The adventure begins with your flight from Anchorage. You will fly over the waters of Cook Inlet and across the tundra and lakes of the foothills of the Alaska Range. As you wing your way through beautiful Lake Clark Pass you will see white-capped mountains and blue glaciers, and possibly moose, sheep and bears. Finally, you will find yourself over Lake Clark with majestic mountains all around.

If you have chosen to fly in a float plane you will land right at the lodge after a spectacular flight. If you have flown a regularly scheduled flight from Anchorage you will land in Port Alsworth, and we will either pick you up there in our boat, or you will transfer to a float plane for the 10 minute flight to Island Lodge.

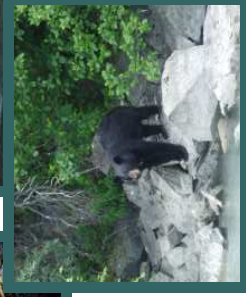
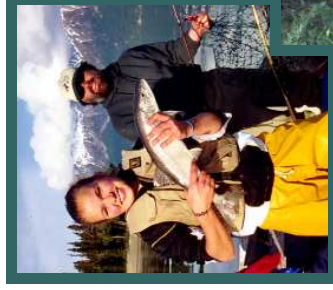
Activities at Island Lodge

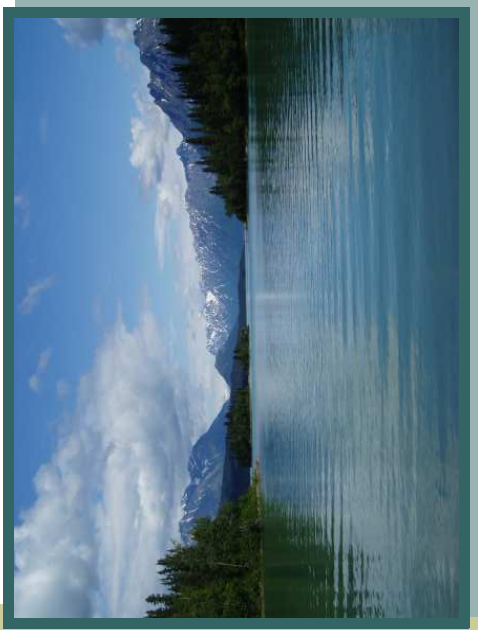

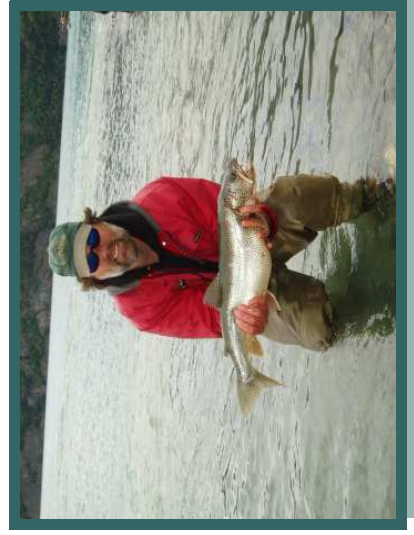

Fishing at Island Lodge

Lake Clark is home to many species of fish that are fun and challenging to catch. A stay at Island Lodge can include fishing every day, a combination of fishing and other activities, or no fishing at all! A typical day of fishing might go like this:

After a hearty breakfast you will head out with a knowledgeable and experienced guide in one of our 18 foot boats, powered by a 50 hp engine. You might start at the head of Lake Clark, fishing the streams that enter the lake for Arctic Grayling and Arctic Char. After a morning of excellent fishing you’ll have lunch—either a shore lunch featuring your catch, or a delicious meal, packed for you by our kitchen staff. In the afternoon—you may try for the ferocious Northern Pike, or possibly troll for that lunker Lake Trout. Sometimes we are distracted from fishing by wildlife that happens by, or by a hike to some waterfalls. By late afternoon the sauna at the lodge will be fired up and waiting for your return. Appetizers and dinner are served in the main lodge and the evening concludes with lots of fish stories!



Rates

Island Lodge is a full service lodge dedicated to making your time in Alaska unforgettable. All three, four and five day packages include lodging, all meals, equipment, guides and a variety of outdoor activities.

Packages: (per person)

- 3 day/4 night \$1,950
- 4 day/5 night \$2,500
- 5 day/6 night \$3,032

Kayaks are available to rent for over-night or multi-day trips. All rentals include spray skirts, paddles, life jackets, pumps, sponge and map of area.

- Single kayak \$60/day
- Double kayak \$80/day

Island Lodge conducts river float trips on several southwest Alaska rivers. Please contact us for pricing.
